GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Our Lucaya Reef Village is the fun, yet tender heart of Grand Bahama Island. The 478-room resort faces 7.5 acres of soft, white sand beach, winding along the sparkling turquoise waters of the gentle Bahamian coast.

This resort residing on the fourth largest of the Bahama islands is alive with Caribbean flair. Arches and columns add a sense of majesty to the airy, sinuous Bahamian-inspired lobby and hallways.

Guest rooms' honey-toned furniture and walls clearly inspired by the sandy beach just a few feet away, are adorned with perfect night sleep beds designed for restful slumber. Each room is artfully simple in design, with Bahamian plantation shutters opening up to spectacular views. More than half of the rooms at Our Lucaya Reef Village directly face the glittering blue ocean. Spacious suites with open floor plans lead out unto wide balconies or patios presenting an unparalleled view of paradise.

Room amenities include cable TV, Internet service, safes, telephones, data ports, hairdryers, coffee makers, kitchenettes, irons/ironing boards and 24-hour room service.

Our Lucaya Reef Village is a tropical getaway for guests of all ages. The resort's renowned Camp Lucaya offers supervised fun in the sun for kids ages three through 12. Children embark on exciting and educational adventures, learning about Bahamian natural wonders and folklore while making new friends with each other and the local wildlife.

While the kids are off at play, moms and dads can escape on their own adventures – as active or uneventful as they please. Whether teeing off at one of the resort's two championship golf courses, playing a tennis match, or simply lounging on the warm beach or by the impressive swimming pools, there is something to suit every fancy.

A nearby 25,000-square-foot fitness center is fully-equipped for a wide variety of workouts and classes – such as Tae Bo and cycling, while the spa offers relaxing massage services and soothing skin care treatments.

Dining at Our Lucaya Reef Village can be a formal or casual affair, with diverse restaurants and lounges to choose from. Family favorites off the grill are sure to please finicky young eaters, while fresh fish and chops and sweet juice concoctions appease more mature tastes.

Our Lucaya Reef Village is part of Our Lucaya, a destination also consisting of The Radisson at Our Lucaya Beach & Golf Resort. Together, Our Lucaya Reef Village and The Radisson offer two unique resort experiences and over 1,200 guest rooms. The Radisson caters to a more adult-crowd with a perfect setting for romance and a large meetings facility. Alternatively, the Our Lucaya Reef Village is geared for families searching for a Caribbean escape, with family-friendly accommodations and an acclaimed children's program. Guests to both resorts have access to the shared golf, spa, dining, meeting and water sports facilities.

DINING

Delicacies from around the globe are tastefully prepared at Our Lucaya Reef Village's four restaurants and lounges. Taste buds journey throughout the Caribbean savoring spicy West Indian flavors, across continents to Latin America, and to classic American fare, at distinct eateries offering formal and informal dining.

KIDS CLUB

Our Lucaya Reef Village, ranked by *Parents* magazine as the number one beach resort for families, hosts Camp Lucaya for kids ages three through 12. The children's program includes snacks and drinks throughout the day, as the little ones enjoy the educational camp facility and are taken out to explore the nature beyond. Young imaginative minds delight in learning Bahamian poetry and folklore.

Meals, arts & crafts, and other special activities are also offered. Babysitting services are also available.

GOLF

Our Lucaya is home to two of the finest golf courses in the Bahamas – The Reef Club and Lucayan Country Club. Both have hosted the PGA's Bahamas National Open, the Senior PGA's Slam, and 12 other national championships.

The Reef Club course created in 2000 by renowned golf architect Robert Trent Jones, Jr., who has designed more than 200 golf courses during his career, sprawls out over 6,930 yards. The 18-hole, par-72 contemporary links-style course offers golfers of all levels a breathtaking layout with 13 holes bordered by picturesque lakes. Its wide fairways and large, level greens require a strong short game.

The 6,824-yard *Lucayan Country Club* course is a classic, originally designed by acclaimed golf course architect Dick Wilson in 1962. The 18-hole, par-72

course is infamous for its shaded, tree-lined fairways, small elevated greens and Wilson-trademark bunkers guarding almost every pin. The Lucayan Country Club provides a true challenge for golfers desiring to put their skill and accuracy to the test.

FITNESS CENTER

Resort guests are immersed in a multi-sensory experience at the 25,000-square-foot spa and fitness center. The Center offers state-of-the-art equipment and fitness classes. Guests can sweat to their hearts' content utilizing a selection of challenging cardio and weight machines, as well as free weights. Personal trainers are also available.

The Center's spa offers relaxing massage and skin treatments, and features a nail and hair salon.

WATER SPORTS & BOATING

Snorkeling and scuba diving equipment and lessons are offered at the resort's Water Sports Center. The Center can also arrange windsurfing, parasailing, banana boating, jet skiing, boating, sailing, fishing, and other "water-ful" adventures that are sure to set the heart alight. The sparkling ocean surface hides an underwater world resplendent with life. Coral reefs attract marlin, sailfish, tuna, mahi-mahi, bonefish and mackerel.

SPORT FACILITIES

Next door, The Radisson at Our Lucaya Beach & Golf Resort serves up the only Fast Grand Slam tennis courts in the Caribbean – innovative facilities which feature replicas of some of the world's best-known court surfaces – such as the red clay of the French Open, the manicured grass of Wimbledon, and the DecoTurf of the U.S. Open. Instruction is available.

CASINO

Other Our Lucaya courts cater to basketball and volleyball.

The casino at Our Lucaya boasts more than 19,000-square-feet of gaming and entertainment with 400 slot machines and 30 gaming tables. From the bustling five-cent slots to the Caribbean stud poker tables, there is a wide assortment of action-packed gambling excitement. The players club offers cash, hotel and meal incentives, and exclusive member-only discounts and invites to special events at the casino.

SHOPPING AND NIGHTLIFE

Directly across from the resort, Port Lucaya Marketplace is a lively, vibrant waterfront-shopping complex with 55 unique shops and 32 restaurants and bars. The marketplace's Count Basie Square comes alive at night as the locals deck out in a rainbow of bright orange, yellow, red and green traditional costumes and lead the crowds in dance and song. Visitors find themselves playing limbo to a heart-thumping Caribbean beat or swaying to melodic Bahamian calypso under the stars. Another popular scene for nightlife is Prop Club, a funky, laid-back beachfront nightclub and dining spot. A favorite among guests, the inside of Prop Club has the look of an old, industrial airplane hangar, with propellers, metal parts and ship hulls hanging all over the walls and ceiling. The Havana Cay Cigar Bar, featuring the finest cigars from Cuba and the Dominican Republic is also a hotspot.

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WEDDINGS AND HONEYMOONS

Enamored couples at Our Lucaya Reef Village can exchange vows on the beach, with the Caribbean sun and gentle sound of ocean waves as the only witnesses, or at a gazebo in the midst of a lovely tropical garden.

GETTING THERE

Our Lucaya Reef Village, lying just 55 miles off the southeastern Florida coast, is easily accessible via non-stop flights to Freeport International Airport (FPO) from Miami, Fort Lauderdale, Atlanta, Charlotte, New York and Philadelphia and with connections from other cities.

Airlines flying to Grand Bahama Island include American Airlines, Bahamasair, Continental, Delta, Spirit Airlines and US Airways.

LOCAL CLIMATE

Sunny and warm all-year-long with gentle trade winds, the average temperature ranges from the low-seventies in the winter to the mid-eighties in the summer. The most refreshing time of the year is September through May, the "dry" season when the temperature averages from seventy to seventy-five degrees Fahrenheit.

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
